**Agency Updates:**

In addition to the updates provided by NJTPA and DVRPC, which are included in the slide presentation, the following updates were provided by member agencies:

- Pennsylvania DOT (Bob Pento): Noted that PennDOT is mainstreaming the use of the VPP data. Initially they were using it for their 511 system. They are integrating it into the ATMS in the Philadelphia area for incidents and travel times. PennDOT is also using



the data for work zone applications in real-time and for planning. They are using the VPP Suite to support their performance measures work.

- Virginia DOT (Scott Cowherd): Currently VDOT is evaluating all three of the VPP vendors on ten roadways. Scott noted that they may have results to share with this group during the next VPP Agency Project Team webcast.
- Florida DOT (Jo Ann Oerter, Atkins for FDOT): FDOT is continuously looking at the data and how they can incorporate it into their operations.
