Unpaid toll event in the lane is imported into the Violation Processing System	➡	Video Toll is successfully posted to the E-ZPass account via either tag read or license plate identification	➡	Closed
If not resolved ↓				
Notice of Toll Violation Issued (ie. First Notice)	➡	Amount Due is Toll + \$25 Administrative Fee. If paid in full or successfully appealed by due date.	➡	Closed
If not resolved ↓				
Final Notice of Toll Violation Generates 42 days after <i>first notice</i> "Notice Date"	➡	Amount Due is Toll + \$25 Administrative Fee + \$25 Civil Penalty Fee + \$12.50 Civil Penalty Surcharge. If paid in full or successfully appealed by due date.	➡	Closed
If not resolved ↓				
Violation Goes to Collections Status	➡	*Notice remains in-house up to 2 calendar months. If paid in full or successfully appealed.	➡	Closed

DE REGISTRATION HOLD

- Delaware residents and businesses
- Tolls and violation fees totaling over \$150.00
- Payment agreement option:
 - 20% down plus 10 monthly payments
 - If defaulted then they are sent to collections
- Since its inception in June 2011, we have applied 1,209 registration holds resulting in \$350k in tolls and violations revenue.
