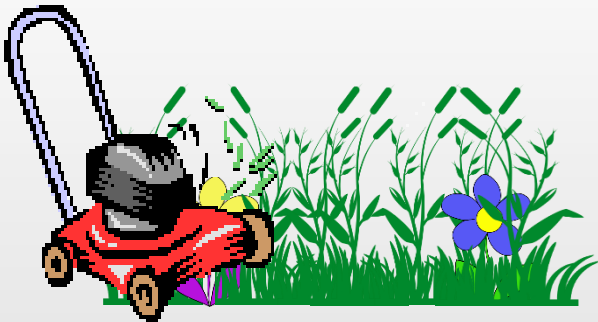
Transportation Agencies: Next Steps
